## Prof. Radosław Owczuk's Letter to the academic community

Four Faculties, One University

Ladies and Gentlemen – Employees, Doctoral Students and Students of the Medical University of Gdańsk,

This academic year is an extraordinary year. As a society, as the inhabitants of Pomerania and, ultimately, as people professionally and academically connected with the University, we make choices. We have already elected members the parliament, we voted for local government representatives, and, in April, we will elect the person who will perform the honourable function of the Rector of our University for the next four years. And similarly to those elections, this vote will have a significant impact on our lives and the quality of our work. It will also affect our families and our patients.

Being the rector of such a university is not only a privilege, but, first of all, it means a great responsibility and hard work. In any case, that is how it should be, in my opinion. I understand being a rector as serving those whose actions depend on the quality and speed of decisions. But also, on the awareness that these decisions produce tangible results for each and every one of us, teachers and researchers, staff, postgraduate and graduate students, organizational units at every level, and ultimately, the university as a whole as a community.
